**REMARK ON THE PROPHET: LAWYER MOVES SUPREME COURT SEEKING  
FORMER BJP SPOKESPERSON NUPUR SHARMA'S ARREST**

A PIL has been filed in the instance case of **Abu Soheli v. Nupur Sharma & Ors** for the controversy remarks for Prophet in order to detain former BJP Spokesperson Nupur Sharma for her alleged hate speech against the venerated Prophet Mohammad and hurting Muslim sensibilities

According to the petition, Sharma, an Indian politician and former national spokesperson for the Bharatiya Janata Party, insulted Islam and the Prophet Mohammad at a televised discussion on May 27, 2022, while speaking for her party on national television.

According to the petitioner, "such provocative abusive communal speech" on the Prophet Mohammad in the national media is intended to sow the seeds of intergroup animosity, and Sharma's deliberate actions are causing discord and upsetting the equilibrium in societies across India at the expense of public peace and tranquilly.

The petition claims that Sharma's offensive remarks have stoked significant turmoil and outcry both domestically and abroad and have damaged the reputation of our nation.

The petition Sled through Advocate Abu Soheli and Advocate Chand Qureshi has asked for quick action against Sharma for her utterances, which violate the Constitution's Articles 14, 15, 21, 26, and 29 as well as other fundamental rights.

According to the petitioner, inciting hate against a certain group of people is a criminal offence that includes intolerance, ideological supremacy, and prejudice
